THEORY

COMPARATIVES: change // make comparisons:

> Change:

My son gets older and older Everything is getting worse

> Make comparisons:

My sister is **older** <u>than</u> me / Mi hermana es <u>más</u> <u>mayor <u>que</u> yo He is more <u>intelligent</u> <u>than</u> you / Es <u>más</u> <u>inteligente</u> <u>que</u> tú</u>

- We often use "the" with comparative adjectives to show that one thing depends on another:

The faster you drive, the more dangerous it is.

(= When you drive faster, it is more dangerous.)

The higher they climbed, the colder it got.

- (= When they climbed higher, it got colder.)
- Comparativos de superioridad:

ADJECTIVE I// 2 sylables : Subject + verb+ adjective -er "than" + object

She is taller than me

ADJECTIVE 2//+ syllables: Subject + verb+ more adjective "than" + object

This exercise is more difficult than the previous one

Comparativos de inferioridad:

"not as...as" // "less...than"

She is **not** as good as him.

Lara is **less** <u>organised</u> **than** you.

Comparativos de igualdad:

"as...as"

Los Angeles is as big as New York.

SUPERLATIVES (el más)

"The + adjective + -est"

"The most + adjective"

If the adjective is possessive, we don't use "the"

His smartest student is David.
