THEORY

NEGATIVE FORM OF THE PAST SIMPLE

- Present simple: Subject (**We**) + **do not** + infinitive without “to”(talk)
- Past simple: Subject (**We**) + **did not** + infinitive without “to”(talk)

I/You/He/She/It/We/You/They + **did not** = **didn't** + verb(infinitive) \neq

Examples: *He didn't finish his homework.*

I did not go to the cinema.

EXCEPTION: was/ were

Was not = wasn't

I wasn't aware of it

Were not = weren't

We weren't prepare for the exam

INTERROGATIVE FORM OF THE PAST SIMPLE

- Present simple: **Do** + subject (**you**) + infinitive without “to”(like)+ (object) ?
- Past simple: **Did** + subject (**you**)+infinitive without “to”(like) + (object) ?

Did + I/You/He/She/It/We/You/They/ + verb(infinitive) \neq ?

Examples: *Did you watch the new episode?*

Did you play volleyball yesterday?

EXCEPTION: was/ were

Was / Were + subject + verb ?

Were you able to complete your trip as planned
